COLLECTION OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may collect and store your information in a variety of ways. The information we may collect on our site and contact points includes:

Personal Data:

Personally identifiable information such as name, shipping and email address, telephone number and demographic information such as age, gender, hometown, place of origin, and any information you voluntarily give to us upon registration to our mailing list, services provided, or with the usage of our Site. You are under no obligation to provide us with any personal information of any kind, however we will inform you that refusal to do so may prevent you from using certain features of our Site, or will prevent our team from answering specific questions and requests.

Social Network Data:

User information from social networking sites connected to Quantum Safety such as Google+, LinkedIn, Facebook, Twitter, WhatsApp, etc., including your name, social network username, location, gender, birth date, email address, profile picture, place of origin, and public data for contacts, if you connect such information to your social networks. Mobile Device Data:

Device information linked to your computer or mobile device including but not limited to: Device ID, model and manufacturer, IP address and information about your location of your device if you access our site.

Third-Party Data:

Information from third parties, such as personal information or network friends and contacts, and if you connect your account to a third party in common and grant the Site permission to access this information if such a request is made.

Financial Data:

Any financial information related to Quantum Safety, such as data related to your payment method (e.g. valid credit card number, card brand or bank, expiration date) that we may collect when you register for any services provided, or request information from our services from the Site. [We store very limited, if any, financial information that we collect. Otherwise, financial information is stored through our secure bank transactions (J.P Morgan & Chase Bank), and we encourage you to review their privacy policy and contact them directly for any question, query or financial information in response to any questions related to your transactions or banking statements].

Derivative Data:

Our servers automatically collect information such as your IP address, browser type, operating system, access times, and pages viewed directly before and after accessing the site. If accessed from a mobile device our servers may also collect your device name and type, operating system or version, phone number, country and city, likes and replies to relevant posts, and other interactions with the website and other users via server log files, as well as any information you provide.

Mobile-Site Information

If you connect to us using our mobile website, related social media servers or any contact point Quantum Safety uses:

- *Geo-Location Information.* We may request access or permission to track location-based information from your mobile device, either continuously or while you are accessing our website, to provide location-based services. If you wish to change our access or permissions at any point, you may do so in your device's settings.
- *Mobile Device Access.* We may request access or permission to certain features from your mobile device's [Bluetooth, calendar, camera, contacts, microphone, speakers, reminders, SMS messages, social media accounts] and other features. If you wish to change our access or permissions at any point, you may do so in your device's settings.

- *Mobile Device Data.* We and our host servers may collect device information (such as your mobile device ID, model and manufacturer) IP address, operating system or version.
- *Push notifications.* We may request to send you push notifications regarding any registration or requested information from our team or services. If you wish to opt-out from receiving these types of communications you may unsubscribe from our mailing lists, request our team cease informing you of any information, or turn them off in your device's settings.

NEW YORK STATE PRIVACY LAWS

New York has recently enacted two law expanding its breach of notification and security safeguards requirements and may be poised to pass a third bill aimed at increasing the privacy rights of New York residents. On July 25, 2019, New York Governor Andrew m. Cuomo signed into law the [Stop Hacks and Improve Electronic Data Security Act \(“SHIELD”\)](#) and [the Identity Theft prevention and Mitigation Services Acts](#). Together, these bills expand the type of personal information covered by new York’s data breach reporting law, requiring businesses to implement specific data security safeguards, and demands any business regulated as a credit reporting agency (“CRA”) provide identity theft prevention and mitigation services to affected consumers for five years—a new high water mark for such requirements.
